

HP Pavilion/Diridon Area Multi-Space Meter Project

On June 16, 2009 the City Council approved the installation of multi-space meters in the vicinity of the HP Pavilion and Diridon Station. The purpose of this flyer is to provide you with information regarding the pending installation of multi-space meters in your neighborhood.

What are Multi-Space Parking Meters?

Multi-space parking meters are a single pay station that can serve multiple parking spaces. The advanced technology associated with the new meters will allow multiple payment options outside the traditional coin operated meters, including bills and credit cards.

Where will the Multi-Space Parking Meters be installed?

A new parking meter zone will be developed and approximately 18 multi-space meters servicing about 150 parking spaces will be installed on (See map on back):

- Autumn Street between Santa Clara Street and Park Street
- Montgomery Street between Santa Clara Street and Park Street
- San Fernando Street between Montgomery Street and Autumn Street


What is the purpose of the Multi-Space Parking Meters?

The primary use of the new meter zone will be for HP Pavilion events and to accommodate all-day commuter parking in the areas that are currently unrestricted. Revenues generated by the multi-space parking meters will be used to support a variety of activities and services provided by the City during events at the HP Pavilion and in the vicinity of the Diridon Station. These services include: traffic control, implementing signal timing plans and making real-time adjustments to optimize traffic flow, monitoring neighborhoods for parking intrusion and cleaning.

When will the Multi-Space Parking Meters be installed?

It is anticipated that the new meters will be installed and operational in Fall 2009.
