  - San Jose Unified School District. Approved with funding not to exceed \$16,000.

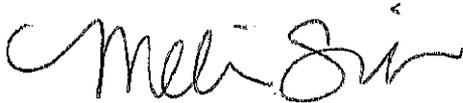
