### NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DEADLINE FOR REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST A CITY MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK

NOTICE IS GIVEN that on Tuesday, November 6, 2012 a Special Municipal Election will be held in the City of San José, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

#### MINIMUM WAGE

Shall an ordinance be adopted that (1) requires (a) payment of minimum wages in San José at \$10 per hour with an annual increase, if any, based on the Consumer Price Index beginning January 1, 2014; (b) City enforcement through fines, penalties, civil actions, or revocation or suspension of permits or licenses; and (c) voter approval of substantive changes to the ordinance; and (2) allows private enforcement through civil actions?



NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Section 9285 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the author or a majority of authors of an argument relating to a City measure may prepare and submit a rebuttal argument, or may authorize in writing any other person or persons to prepare, submit, or sign the rebuttal argument. **No rebuttal argument may not exceed 250 words in length, and must be accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the person(s) submitting it.**

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, the City Clerk has fixed **12:00 Noon, Tuesday, August 21, 2012** during normal office hours, as posted, as the deadline for rebuttal arguments to be submitted to the clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in the Article 4. Rebuttal arguments may be changed or withdrawn until the deadline fixed by the City Clerk.
