**SUBJECT: CONTINUATION AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES WITH SOUND TECHNOLOGY CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR THE SAN JOSE MCENERY CONVENTION CENTER SOUND SYSTEM RENOVATION PROJECT**

## RECOMMENDATION

Approval of a continuation agreement for consultant services with Sound Technology Consultants, Inc., for the San Jose McEnery Convention Center Sound System Renovation Project, extending the term of the agreement from August 31, 2004 to May 31, 2005, at no cost to the City.

CEQA: Not a project.

## BACKGROUND

On June 25, 2002, Council approved an agreement with Sound Technology Consultants, Inc. for design, engineering and construction support of a new, high-quality sound system featuring both music and speech capabilities at the San José McEnery Convention Center. The consultant agreement includes services for commissioning the installed systems through the one-year warranty period of the project. Construction began in August 2002 and was completed in August 2003.

## ANALYSIS

The original agreement terminated at the completion of the project construction (August 2003). The first amendment extended the agreement through the commissioning period of the project, August 2004. Basic commissioning of the multi-million dollar audio/video system is complete. This continuation agreement extension is to retroactively retain the consultant under contract in order to provide necessary post-commissioning system software updates, training and support services to convention center staff and their exhibitors as stated under the scope of services in the

agreement. These services are being provided at no additional cost. The continuation agreement provides for the services to be provided through May 31, 2005, without interruption.

This agreement and memorandum have been coordinated with the Departments of Finance, Planning, Building and Code Enforcement, Team San José, and the City Attorney's Office and the City Manager's Budget Office.


