1. State

- a. State Legislative Update - Redevelopment Bills  
AB 2922 (Jones) – Amended: Low and Moderate Income

Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Oppose.

Housing Fund: 35% set aside  
SB 1206 (Kehoe) – Redevelopment Reform

Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Oppose.

AB 2197 (Devore) – bill withdrawn

Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Oppose/Continue to watch.

- b. State Housing Legislation  
AB 2638 (Laird – Housing Trust Fund  
AB 2800 (Laird) – Housing Anti-Discrimination  
SB 1289 (Cedillo) – Emancipating Foster Youth  
AB 2961 (Nunez) – Homeless Assistance Payments
- Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Support on all four of the bills.
- c. Proposition 81: California Reading and Literacy Improvement and Public Library Construction and Renovation Bond Act of 2006
- Proposition 82: Preschool Education, Tax on Incomes Over \$400,000 for Individuals; \$800,000 for Couples
- Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Support on both propositions.
- d. AB 2435 (Coto) – Santa Clara Valley Water District
- Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Support.
- e. SB 1611 (Simitian) – Congestion Management Fees
- Action: The Committee approved the Staff's recommendation to take a position of Support.
