

Taxicab Service Model – City of San Jose

UFCW Proposed Changes To Staff's Proposal of 3/18/04

1. Clarify that all owner-operator drivers, not just those with airport permits, will have free movement between companies. The City should consider a uniform color scheme of taxicabs in order to facilitate movement of drivers between companies.
2. Airport permits – issue a total of 240 permits (170 to existing regular airport drivers, 70 to cab companies). Use rotating schedule.
3. During peak time, all airport permitted cabs may pick up at the airport on a first-come, first served basis. Airport officials and Management Company shall be given reasonable discretion to declare other peak times and allow open access. Drivers will be allowed to resolve disputes over application of peak time rules through access to airport officials. The peak time system should be monitored during the transition period to determine if all parties are better served by allowing first-come, first-served access on all days.
4. All parties agree on a goal of adequate customer service (no liquidated damages) and an average of at least 10 fares per day for airport drivers. System to be re-evaluated and numbers adjusted if necessary in 60 days. Airport permits made available by drivers leaving the system shall first go to current airport drivers who did not get a permit, and then to additional drivers on a waiting list.
5. Permits should be issued to the cab as well as the driver. This will allow airport-permitted driver to lease his cab for an additional shift. (note – this will help address the city's concern over adequate supply at the airport.)
6. Airport permits should be renewed bi-annually, to conform with renewal of regular city permit.
7. Drivers should be allowed to take an unlimited number of "vacations" for up to a total of three months per year without restriction.
8. Include public input (including all stakeholders) in airports discretionary "adjustment" of number of permits.
9. New companies or entities (association) shall be allowed to operate at the airport if they show written intent from at least 15 current airport-permitted drivers to affiliate with them and all other city requirements, including service standards, are met.
10. During the transition period, gate fees charged by companies, excluding insurance, shall not be increased above those charged as of 3-1-04 except to conform with adjustments in the consumer price index.

11. Companies shall have discretion to reduce fares by no more than 10%. Further reductions will require consensus of drivers.
12. Clarify that dispute resolution includes procedures outlined in the UFCW proposal, as amended.
13. Total number of taxicab permits in the City shall be capped and reduced by attrition to 400.
14. An independent body shall be established to consider appropriate numbers of permits to be issued in the future as well as other issues related to the industry. As an interim measure, the San Jose Appeals Board shall meet quarterly, or as necessary, as a Taxicab Board. When meeting as the Taxicab Board, the Board shall include three additional members, one representing taxicab drivers, one representing taxicab companies, and one representing the disabled community.
15. Within one year of the implementation of this new system, the City, with the guidance of the Taxi Advisory Team, shall develop and implement procedures that allow owner-operator drivers to transfer their permits to another driver (who has met City permitting requirements) upon retiring or leaving the industry.
