Transportation Development Act, Article 3 (TDA 3) Funding**

Ongoing Programs

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| 1. | <u>Pedestrian & Bicycle Facility Signing & Striping</u>
Stripe crosswalks and install other pedestrian facility improvements;
stripe bike lanes and install other bicycling improvements. | \$ 50,000 |
| 2. | <u>Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety Education</u>
Through the City's School Safety Program, provide safe walking and
bicycling education in the City's grade K-9 schools. In addition, offer
adult Safe Bicycling courses to the public six times per year. | \$ 50,000 |
| 3. | <u>ADA Wheel Chair Curb Ramps</u>
Install approximately 90 ramps. These funds will allow DOT to
proactively supplement the City's existing ADA curb ramp installation
Program. | \$176,068 |

School Access Improvements

(Recommended by the City's *School Access Enhancement Study*)

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| 4. | <u>Ann Darling Elementary School</u>
Install sidewalk, curb and gutter improvements on the south side of
Marburg Way at North 33 rd Street. (CD 3) | \$ 90,000 |
| 5. | <u>Cedar Grove Elementary School</u>
For school drop off and pickup, install concrete pad on park strip at
Sugarplum Drive at Peppermint Drive. (CD 8) | \$ 36,000 |
| 6. | <u>Yerba Buena High School</u>
Install median island pedestrian refuge, asphalt concrete pavement,
crosswalks and traffic signs at Phelan Avenue and Roberts Avenue. (CD7) | \$185,000 |
