RECOMMENDATION

Adoption of a resolution extending the Strong Neighborhoods Initiative Project Advisory Committee to March 31, 2008 and extending the term of the current members.

OUTCOME

Adoption of a resolution will extend the Strong Neighborhoods Initiative Project Advisory Committee to March 31, 2008 and will extend the term of its current members.

BACKGROUND

In June 2001, the Strong Neighborhoods Initiative Project Area Committee was established to fulfill the redevelopment legal requirements and to serve as an advisory body for the implementation of the Strong Neighborhoods Initiative redevelopment plan. The term of the Project Area Committee ended June 30, 2005. On May 10, 2005, the Council approved the formation of a new Strong Neighborhoods Initiative Project *Advisory* Committee ("SNI PAC") to serve for a two-year period ending June 30, 2007, so that the City could continue to obtain the input and advice of affected community members.

On May 22, 2007, the City Council approved the Neighborhood Services and Education Committee's recommendation to extend the Strong Neighborhoods Initiative Project Advisory Committee to March 31, 2008. Further Council action is necessary. Since the Strong Neighborhoods Initiative Project Advisory Committee was created by resolution (Council Resolution No. 72664), a resolution is needed to extend it.


On March 28, 2007, the SNI PAC agreed to request an extension to March 31, 2008.
