RECOMMENDATION

As recommended by the Parks and Recreation Commission, name a new park located at the intersection of Floyd and Locust Streets as the "Parque de Padre Mateo Sheedy."

BACKGROUND

The process calls for the Commission(s) to hold a public hearing on nominations prior to forwarding a recommendation to the City Council.

Earlier this year, nominations were received proposing to name the park located at the intersection of Floyd and Locust Streets.


