**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE
REPEALING PART 22 OF CHAPTER 2.08 OF TITLE 2 OF
THE SAN JOSE MUNICIPAL CODE AND AMENDING IN
ITS ENTIRETY PART 28 OF CHAPTER 2.08 OF TITLE 2
TO CONSOLIDATE THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) STEERING COMMITTEE AND
THE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMISSION INTO THE NEW
COMMISSION NAMED THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION (HACDAC)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

SECTION 1. Part 22 of Chapter 2.08 of Title 2 of the San José Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Part 28 of Chapter 2.08 of Title 2 of the San José Municipal Code is hereby amended in its entirety to be numbered and entitled and to read as follows:

Part 28

Housing and Community Development Advisory Commission

2.08.2800 Commission Established

The Housing and Community Development Advisory Commission is hereby established.

2.08.2810 Members

No later than January 1, 2007, the Commission shall consist of nine (9) members plus a nonvoting senior representative.

2.08.2820 Special Eligibility Requirements

No later than January 1, 2007, the Commission shall consist of two (2) members who are each a resident of Council Districts 3, 5, and 7 and three (3) at-large members, not residents of Council Districts 3, 5, or 7. Any other special eligibility requirements are set forth in the Commission's Citizen Participation Plan, as may be amended from time to time.

2.08.2830 Functions, Powers and Duties

The Commission shall have the following functions, powers, and duties.

- A. Study, review, evaluate and make recommendations to the City Council and the Department of Housing of the City of San José, pertaining to the following matters:
 - 1. Existing housing programs and policies in the City of San José.
 - 2. New programs and policies that would further the City of San José's housing goals.
 - 3. The City of San José's progress in meeting its housing goals.
- B. Submit recommendations and reports to the City Council and the City Manager regarding housing policy in the City of San José as the City Council or the City Manager may from time to time request.
- C. Hold public hearings in order to provide for meaningful citizen participation in the development and implementation of the CDBG program.

- D. Make such studies, and submit to the Council such reports or recommendations respecting affordable housing and CDBG matters, as the Council may from time to time require or request.

- E. Develop proposals and recommendations to the City Council for use of CDBG funds.
