

RESOLUTION NO. 73331

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**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
JOSE ESTABLISHING THE FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007
PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL
OBLIGATION BOND INDEBTEDNESS**

WHEREAS, at the City of San José's ("City") general election held on November 7, 2000, voters approved Measure O (Neighborhood Libraries Bond) and Measure P (Safe Neighborhood Parks and Recreation Bond) in the not-to-exceed respective amounts of \$211,790,000 and \$228,030,000 authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2001, the City Council of the City of San José ("City Council") approved the issuance of the first series of general obligation bonds in the amount of \$71,000,000 (\$31,000,000 for neighborhood libraries and \$40,000,000 for neighborhood parks and recreation), and the sale of these bonds occurred and the proceeds were received in 2001; and

WHEREAS, at the City's general election held on March 5, 2002, voters approved Measure O (911, Fire, Police, Paramedic and Neighborhood Security Act) in the not-to-exceed amount of \$159,000,000 authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2002, the City Council approved the issuance of general obligation bonds, including the second series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2000) and Measure P and the first series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2002), in the aggregate amount of \$116,090,000 (\$30,000,000 for neighborhood libraries, \$46,715,000 for neighborhood parks and recreation and \$39,375,000 for public safety), and the sale of these bonds occurred and the proceeds were received in 2002; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2004, the City Council approved the issuance of general obligation bonds, including the third series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2000) and Measure P, and the second series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2002), in the aggregate amount of \$118,700,000 (\$58,300,000 for neighborhood libraries, \$46,000,000 for neighborhood parks and recreation and \$14,400,000 for public safety), and the sale of these bonds occurred and the proceeds were received in 2004; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2005, the City Council approved the issuance of general obligation bonds, including the fourth series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2000), and the third series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2002), in the aggregate amount of \$46,300,000 (\$21,300,000 for neighborhood libraries and \$25,000,000 for public safety), and the sale of these bonds occurred and the proceeds were received in 2005; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2006, the City Council approved the issuance of general obligation bonds, including the fifth series of general obligation bonds under Measure O (2000), and the fourth series of general obligation bonds under Measure P, in the aggregate amount of \$105,400,000 (\$60,000,000 for neighborhood libraries and \$45,400,000 for neighborhood parks and recreation), and the sale of these bonds occurred and the proceeds were received in 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City is obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all property within the City subject to taxation by the City, without limitation of rate or amount (except with respect to certain personal property which is taxed at limited rates), for the payment of the debt service on the above-described bonds (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the City is obligated to direct the County of Santa Clara to collect such ad valorem taxes in such amounts and at such times as is necessary to ensure the timely payment of debt service on the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the annual ad valorem tax levied by the City to repay the Bonds is determined by the relationship between the assessed valuation of taxable property in the City and the amount of debt service due on the Bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 14.28 of the San José Municipal Code, an ad valorem property tax is hereby established to be levied on all land and improvements in the City of San José during fiscal year 2006-2007 in the amount of 0.02930 per \$100 in assessed value for the secured and utility tax roll and in the amount of 0.02580 per \$100 in assessed value for the unsecured tax roll based on the calculations set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

2. The City's Director of Finance shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be delivered to the Auditor of the County of Santa Clara for entry in the assessment book of the respective sums in dollars and cents, to be paid as established by this Resolution.

EXHIBIT A

The total debt service requirement for the Bonds for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 is \$36,126,320. This amount includes the County of Santa Clara administrative fee of \$90,091, which is approximately 0.25% of the principal and interest due. The secured and utility net assessed value for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 is \$102,158,358,897. The tax rate for the secured and utility tax roll for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 is 0.02930 per \$100 in assessed value. The unsecured roll is included in the calculation for the following series of the Bonds for the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 levy: Series 2001, Series 2002, Series 2004 and Series 2005 Bonds. The unsecured net assessed value for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 is \$7,031,911,369. The tax rate for the unsecured tax roll for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 is 0.02580 per \$100 in assessed value.
