

RESOLUTION NO. 74085

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR A GRANT TO ASSIST IN THE FUNDING OF THE AIRPORT'S COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS FUELING STATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$527,000, TO ACCEPT THE GRANT IF AWARDED, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, in August 2003, the City of San Jose ("City") opened the Compressed Natural Gas ("CNG") fueling station at the Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport ("Airport"), making it the only CNG station in California owned and operated by an airport; and

WHEREAS, the Airport's CNG fueling station was initially designed to support twenty CNG shuttle buses acquired in 2003, other CNG vehicles used in Airport operations, and CNG vehicles used by private entities; and

WHEREAS, by 2008, the Airport will replace its remaining twenty diesel shuttle buses, used to transport customers and passengers from the terminals to the rental car center with a fleet of fourteen new CNG shuttle buses; and

WHEREAS, the addition of the fourteen new CNG buses requires modification of the station so that fueling of the buses during non-peak hours can continue; and

WHEREAS, in March 2007, a Transportation Fund Clean Air (“TFCA”) grant application was submitted to the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (“VTA”) to fund this upgrade project; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the City will be required to provide a match equaling \$200,000 from Airport sources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to execute and submit an application to the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority for a grant to assist in the upgrade of the Airport’s Compressed Natural Gas fueling station in an amount not to exceed \$527,000.
2. The City Manager is further authorized to accept the grant on behalf of the City and to execute any necessary documents to effectuate the grant.
