RECOMMENDATION

That the Council interview six applicants and make appointments to fill two, three-year terms ending December 31, 2009 and one unexpired term ending December 31, 2007 on the Appeals Hearing Board.

BACKGROUND

The Office of the City Clerk advertised during August for two terms ending December 31, 2006 and one recent resignation to fill an unexpired term ending December 31, 2007. There were ten applicants, six of whom participated in the Project Diversity interview process.

In October 2003, Council amended the process for interviewing applicants to the Board. For interviewing five or more applicants, the process is as follows:

1. The Project Diversity Screening committee shall interview all applicants.
2. The City Clerk shall forward to Council the list of applicants, along with the Project Diversity Screening Committee recommendations.
3. Each Councilmember shall submit to the Clerk, in writing, a list of applicants recommended for interview by the whole Council.
4. Council shall interview the following:
 - a. If there is one vacancy, council shall interview the 4 applicants who receive the greatest number of indications of interest.
 - b. If there are 2 vacancies, council shall interview up to 6 applicants who receive the greatest number of indications of interest.
 - c. If there are 3 vacancies, council shall interview up to 8 applicants who receive the greatest number of indications of interest.

BACKGROUND

This Office routinely reviews applications to City Boards, Commissions and Committees. The applications do not provide complete information; however, they do occasionally disclose potential conflicts of interest or incompatible offices. The purpose of this memorandum is to highlight major areas of potential conflict that are disclosed by the applications. In order to analyze potential conflicts it is necessary to consider the duties of the particular commission or committee to which the applicant is seeking appointment.

COMMISSION DUTIES

The Appeals Hearing Board sits as a quasi-judicial Board which hears code enforcement appeals of blighted conditions; illegal building activity; unsafe and unsanitary living conditions; abandoned, dismantled and inoperative vehicles; neglected vacant houses; weed abatement liens; garbage liens; police permittee denials or revocations; sign removal fees; and utility billing and graffiti abatement fees. The Board has the authority to impose certain penalties in lieu of criminal and civil judicial enforcement.

At least one member of the Board must be an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of California.

APPLICANTS

Etienne, Sonja Lynn. – Ms. Etienne is a legal technical writer for Sun Microsystems in Menlo Park. Her application reveals neither pervasive conflicts of interest nor incompatible offices.

Gravink, Eric Allen – Mr. Gravink is an attorney practicing real estate and business law, with the firm of Rossi, Hamerslough, Reischl and Chuck. If a client of Mr. Gravink or his firm was subject to an enforcement matter coming before the Commission, Mr. Gravink would have a potential conflict of interest. His application reveals neither pervasive conflicts of interest nor incompatible offices.

Joglekar, Kaushik, C. -- Mr. Joglekar is employed by Washington Mutual Bank as a Senior Personal Financial Representative. His application reveals no apparent conflicts of interest at neither present nor incompatible offices.

Parker, Jr., Edgar, "David". Mr. Parker is currently a student at San Jose State University and not presently employed. He has a background as a courtroom clerk and has also served on the Sunshine Task Force for San Francisco. His application reveals neither apparent conflicts of interest nor incompatible offices.

Parsons, Karen Gail. Ms. Parsons is employed by @Road in Fremont as a credit and collections manager. She has previously served on the Appeals Hearing Board approximately in 1992, and has also served on the Salary Setting Commission at approximately the same time. Her application reveals no apparent conflicts of interest or incompatible offices.

Pelton, Gary G. Mr. Pelton is retired. His application contains no background as to prior employment or potential conflicts. Thus, his application reveals no apparent conflicts of interest or incompatible offices.

Ruscigno, Susan – Ms. Ruscigno is a staff attorney with Senior Adults Legal Assistance. If a client of Ms. Ruscigno or her firm was subject to an enforcement matter coming before the Commission, Ms. Ruscigno would have a potential conflict of interest. Her application reveals no pervasive conflicts of interest or incompatible offices.

Stuart, Harold H. Mr. Stuart's application states that he is a Senior Software Engineer with Apple Computer. Mr. Stuart's application reveals no potential conflicts of interest or incompatible offices.

Tran, Kiet Anh. Mr. Tran is a Managing Partner of Westpointe Elite. Mr. Tran's application reveals no potential conflicts of interest or incompatible offices.

Wagner, Darrold "Dan". Mr. Wagner is a Risk Services Specialist with the Union Bank of California. His application reveals no potential conflicts of interest or incompatible offices.

CONCLUSION

None of the applicants appear to hold any incompatible offices or to have pervasive conflicts of interest that would preclude them from serving on the Appeals Hearing Board. Each applicant states that he or she resides in San Jose. The Committee may wish to consider the above comments in making its recommendations regarding appointments to the Board.
