

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE FY 2008 LAW ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCES FOR HUMAN TRAFFICKING VICTIMS CONTINUATION GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of San José (“City”) has previously received a grant from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (“BJA”) which grant primarily focused on providing training and education regarding human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted a continuation grant proposal to the BJA under the FY 2008 Law Enforcement Task Forces for Human Trafficking Victims Continuation Grant Program under which the San Jose Police Department would utilize the funds to locate, identify, and rescue victims of human trafficking, and work with the U.S. Attorney’s Office and the Santa Clara County District Attorney’s Office to prosecute human trafficking cases; and

WHEREAS, the BJA has approved the City’s grant proposal in an amount not to exceed \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, under the continuation grant, the City will be required to provide a match equaling \$125,000, which match will be met by the City providing personal services through the use of existing Police Department staffing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept the FY 2008 Law Enforcement Task Forces for Human Trafficking Victims Continuation Grant from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 on behalf of the City
2. The City Manager is further authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the grant.
