Deputy City Manager Ed Shikada provided the staff report on the development of a banner public information signs policy.

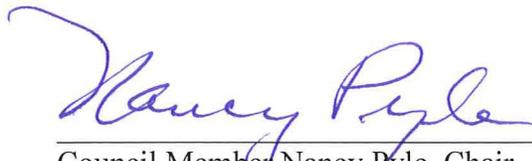
Action: The Committee accepted the Staff report.
