





RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

The Downtown Parking Board was established to serve as a forum for public discussion of downtown parking issues, to help coordinate downtown parking programs, and to increase their effectiveness. The Board, with its mission "to create and maintain a downtown public parking system that provides available and accessible parking", reviews parking system operations, financials, and develops parking recommendations for the City Council and Redevelopment Agency Board. The Parking Board is vital to the development of a successful parking strategy for downtown with effective community involvement.

The recommended appointments are two dedicated individuals with a strong commitment to the Downtown and the parking program and bring with them valuable perspectives.

The reappointment is a Downtown Parking Board member who has demonstrated his commitment to downtown parking programs and represents San Jose State University on the Downtown Parking Board.
