SUBJECT: Sixth Amendment to Agreement
for Legal Services with
Nossaman LLP

DATE: June 9, 2009

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Attorney to negotiate and execute a Sixth Amendment to the Agreement with Nossaman LLP for legal services related to the Design-Build Agreement for the Airport Terminal Area Improvement Program, extending the term from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 with no increase in total compensation.

OUTCOME

Approval of the Sixth Amendment will allow the consultant to continue to provide legal services related to the negotiation of design and construction task orders associated with the Design-Build Agreement for the Airport Terminal Area Improvement Program ("TAIP") between the City and Hensel Phelps Construction Co., the Design-Build Firm.

BACKGROUND

On June 22, 2006, the City Attorney executed a \$100,000 agreement with Nossaman Guthner Knox & Elliott LLP ("Nossaman") for legal services in connection with the negotiation of the Design-Build Agreement for the TAIP. The City Attorney's Office selected Nossaman through a Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") that was distributed to a number of California law firms and advertised on the City and Airport web sites. Nossaman has extensive experience negotiating and advising both public and private owners in connection with the negotiation of design-build agreements.

In order to support the significant staff time and legal services committed to the negotiation of the Design-Build Agreement during the July 2006 Council recess, the City Attorney determined that it was necessary to exercise his authority, pursuant to Resolution No. 64250, to execute a First Amendment to increase the total compensation to \$150,000. On August 15, 2006, Council adopted Resolution No. 73348 authorizing the City Attorney to negotiate and execute a Second Amendment to

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increase the total compensation to \$250,000. On October 17, 2006, Council adopted Resolution No.73448 to negotiate and execute a Third Amendment to increase the total compensation to \$350,000 and extend the term to June 30, 2007. On June 15, 2007, a Minor Contract Amendment was executed extending the Agreement through December 31, 2007, with no increase in total compensation. On January 8, 2008, Council adopted Resolution No. 74200 authorizing the City Attorney to negotiate and executed a Fourth Amendment to continue the term from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008 with no increase in total compensation. On July 1, 2008, Nossaman merged with O'Connor & Hannan LLP and changed its name to Nossaman LLP. On December 11, 2008 a Minor Contract Amendment was executed extending the Agreement through June 30, 2009, with no increase in total compensation.

ANALYSIS

Nossaman has provided vital support to the City Attorney's Office in negotiating and drafting the Design-Build Agreement with Hensel Phelps, as well as assisting in negotiating task orders for design and construction services. The City Attorney's Office is recommending that the Agreement with Nossaman be extended to June 30, 2010 to provide ongoing support to the City Attorney's Office as necessary for the task order negotiations and for other issues that may arise during the course of the TAIP. There will be no increase in total compensation.


