RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS REGARDING THE EXPENDITURE OF AGENCY FUNDS TO ERADICATE GRAFFITI

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Jose ("Agency") is presently engaged in redevelopment activities throughout the City of San Jose; and

WHEREAS, Section 33420.2 of the California Health and Safety Code authorizes a redevelopment agency to take any actions that are necessary to remove graffiti from public or private property upon making a finding that, because of the magnitude and severity of the graffiti within the project areas, the action is necessary to effectuate the purposes of the redevelopment plans, and that the action will assist with the elimination of blight; and

WHEREAS, Agency and City staff report that the presence of graffiti within the project areas is a serious and continuing problem that severely and negatively impacts redevelopment efforts at improvement of the project areas; and

WHEREAS, the Agency's Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Capital Budget includes funding for graffiti eradication; and

WHEREAS, based upon the magnitude and severity of the graffiti within the project areas, funding for eradication of graffiti in the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Capital Budget is necessary to effectuate the purposes of the redevelopment plans and will assist with the elimination of blight.

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NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE HEREBY determines that based upon the magnitude and severity of the graffiti within the project areas, funding for eradication of graffiti in the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Capital Budget is necessary to effectuate the purposes of the redevelopment plans, and will assist with the elimination of blight.
