



I want to become a member of the Planning Commission because I believe I can be an objective and analytical voice on the commission. I have a deep connection to San Jose, because I am a lifelong resident and four generations of my family have called our city home. Our city is on the verge of a population boom, and we are already faced with infrastructure issues such as the gridlock at the 101 and 280 interchange in Evergreen. In these times of economic hardship we need to be open to economic opportunities with an eye towards long-term impacts. As a lawyer I have represented both large corporations and working class individuals. Representing such diverse interests provides me with the necessary objectivity and attention to detail to carry out the duties of the planning commission. In addition, my time on the Evergreen Envisioning Project Task Force gave me insight into the planning process.

My main objective on the board would be to help San Jose become the type of world-class city our citizens deserve. As the 10th largest city we need a vibrant downtown that is both true to the tradition of our city by being family oriented; but also more metropolitan. We need a diverse nightlife that includes live music and will attract tourists. These kind of venues will help bring the type of large conferences that will allow us compete with the Moscone Center in San Francisco. Furthermore, we need smart zoning that allows us to compete with the Stanford Research Park. It is odd that as the Capital of Silicon Valley our city is still largely the stepchild to the Peninsula in the tech industry, in spite of the fact we have a stronger infrastructure than our smaller neighbors to the north.


