

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A 2010-2011 DUI ENFORCEMENT AND AWARENESS PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$382,259, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the State of California Office of Traffic Safety (“OTS”) has established a DUI Enforcement and Awareness Grant Program (“Program”), which is designed to reduce victims killed and injured as a result of DUI drivers; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of San José (“City”) applied for funding from the Program, and has been notified that the City has been awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$382,259; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding will reimburse the City for overtime costs for officers to staff DUI checkpoints and saturation patrols, fund travel costs for sworn personnel to attend Standard Field Testing training, fund the purchase of Preliminary Alcohol Screening devices and Portable Intoxilyzers, and fund certain printing costs related to the California Law Enforcement Challenge; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the grant award for the specified purpose and to authorize the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept a DUI Enforcement and Awareness Program Grant on behalf of the City from the State of California Office of Traffic

Safety in an amount not to exceed \$382,259, and to execute the grant agreement.

2. The City Manager is further authorized to execute any necessary documents to effectuate the grant, including any additional amendments and related documents, without further Council action.
