Valley Health Center Downtown San Jose

- County's highest priority location for new VMC primary-care services
- SJMC closure in 2004 emphasized urgency of need for solution

Funding for Construction

- Voters approved Measure A in 2008
- Authorizes issuing \$50 million in bonds to develop medical facilities in downtown San Jose

Progress to Date

- Former SJMC site purchased
- Gardner Family Health Care selected to provide initial primary-care services
- County decided on best long-term approach to providing healthcare services in downtown San Jose

Phased Approach

- By mid-2011, Gardner starts providing additional primary-care services in MediPlex bldg on SJMC site
- Within 4-5 years, County constructs new Valley Health Center in downtown San Jose
 - Building on County experience developing new VHCs in Sunnyvale, Gilroy & Milpitas





VHC Downtown San Jose

- 3-story, 60,000-sq-ft bldg
- On SE corner of SJMC site
- Services:
 - Primary- & urgent-care clinics
 - Public Health WIC
 - Pharmacy, lab, radiology
- Capacity to care for 25,000 patients

Next Steps

- Continue communications with stakeholders & members of the surrounding community
- Demolish most bldgs on SJMC site
- Open Gardner primary-care clinic by mid-2011
- Adapt VHC Milpitas plan to specifics of SJMC site
- Plan for uses of balance of SJMC site in context of healthcare reform
