RECOMMENDED ACTION:			
<p>Adopt a resolution to repeal Resolution No. 75898 and authorize the Director of Finance to execute the Second Amendment to the Public Address System Agreement with Signatures Technology Inc., dba Com-Net Software to expand the public address system into the Federal Inspections Services International (FIS) Terminal at the Norman Y. Mineta San José International Airport and to increase the compensation by an amount not to exceed \$50,438, from \$2,671,231 to \$2,721,669, including all hardware, software, sales tax, and the first year of support and professional services and warranty.</p>			
BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:			
<p>On June 21, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 75898 to authorize the Director of Finance to execute a Second Amendment with Com-Net Software to expand the public address system into the Federal Inspection Services Internal Terminal at the Airport. The Council Memo and Resolution incorrectly stated the maximum compensation under the agreement is an amount not to exceed \$2,326,707, which did not include the eight different change orders totaling \$394,962 entered into with Com-Net from June 2009 through October 2010 as part of the contingency funds previously approved by Council. Staff is requesting the City Council to adopt a resolution to repeal Resolution No. 75898 that includes the incorrect maximum compensation amount and allow the Director of Finance to execute the Second Amendment with the correct maximum compensation amount of \$2,721,669.</p>
