

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE FY 2011 ENHANCED COLLABORATIVE MODEL TO COMBAT HUMAN TRAFFICKING GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000, AND TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of San José (“City”) previously applied to the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (“BJA”), for a grant to be utilized to locate, identify, and rescue victims of human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, the City has received notification from the BJA that the City has been awarded a 2011 Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking grant in the amount of \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, over the two-year term of the grant, the City, as lead agency of the Task Force, will utilize the grant funds to work with the U.S. Attorney’s Office and the Santa Clara County District Attorney’s Office to prosecute human trafficking cases, and to continue to provide training to law enforcement professionals, educate health and social services agencies and victim advocates, and conduct public outreach regarding human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, the City will be required to provide a match equaling \$166,667, which will be met by in-kind services provided by current City staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept the FY 2011 Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Grant on behalf of the City from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.

2. The City Manager is further authorized to execute the grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, and to execute any related documents necessary to effectuate the grant.
