RECOMMENDATION

On December 7, 2011, the Rules and Open Government Committee approved a recommendation from Councilmember Pyle to appoint Elizabeth Pope and John Legois to the Disability Advisory Commission to terms expiring June 30, 2014 as noted by staff. Due to a clerical error, the terms were not accurately reported and one person should be appointed to fill an unexpired term and one person should be appointed to a full three-year term. The Office of the City Clerk conducted a random draw to assign terms, and the recommendation has been revised to reflect the proper terms. Therefore,

(a) Appoint Elizabeth Pope to an unexpired term ending June 30, 2013 and John Legois to a term expiring June 30, 2014 to the Disability Advisory Commission. (Pyle).

RECOMMENDATION:

The reappointment of Ashok Naidu to another complete term on the Advisory Commission on Rents.

BACKGROUND:

The commission advises the City Council and the Administration on the Rental Dispute and Mediation hearing process and recommends changes or amendments to improve the administration of this hearing process. This commission is composed of two tenant representatives that must live in rent controlled apartments, two landlord representatives, and three neutral positions.
