

Execute an agreement with Santa Clara Valley Medical Center (SCVMC) for Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) exams for adults and children as mandated by SB768 and as required by the San Jose Police Department, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$150,000 for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013; and 2. Exercise annual extensions to the agreement and execute any required documentation for ongoing services as required under the terms and conditions of the agreement, subject to the appropriation of funds; and | | | |
| Desired Outcome: To continue the expeditious and cost effective testing for adult and child victims of suspected sexual assaults. | | | |
| BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION: | | | |
| <p>Historically, the City has purchased SART exams from SCVMC using an Open Purchases Order as the form of contract. Last year, Santa Clara County required a formal agreement which was subsequently executed between the City and the County. The term of the agreement is twelve months. In order to make the annual renewal as efficient as possible, staff requests the authority to extend the agreement for additional 12 month renewal periods each upon receipt and acceptance of a renewal quotation from the County.</p> <p>Section 4.12.225 of the San José Municipal Code authorizes the City to contract for these services directly from another public agency without observing the competitive procurement requirements.</p> <p>Summary of SCVM Amendment: In the event SCVMC increases the exam rates, SCVMC shall submit to the City a renewal quote at least 30 days prior to the end of the then current term of the agreement. The Agreement may be terminated by either party with ten days written notice. In the unlikely event that this Agreement is terminated by the County, the County will complete SART and lab processing services that are in process prior to termination and the City will arrange for an alternative delivery of services either through a similar cooperative agreement with another public agency or through a competitive solicitation.</p> <p>This Council item is consistent with Council approved Budget Strategy General Principles #2 “We must focus on protecting our vital core City services”.</p> | | | |
