

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE 2012 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$283,934 AND EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO EFFECTUATE THE GRANT, INCLUDING THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND THE NECESSARY MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose ("City") has been participating in the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") program since 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County of Santa Clara ("County") have been certified as disparate jurisdictions by the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, certified disparate jurisdictions are given funding amounts and expected to come to an understanding regarding sharing of the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding has been developed by the City regarding the 2012 JAG program, which identifies the City as the lead Fiscal Agent for the grant and outlines the allocations for the City and the County; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 JAG grant application was submitted by the City on May 14, 2012 on behalf of the City and the County as participating agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to accept the 2012 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$283,934 and execute any documents required to effectuate the grant, including the Grant Agreement and the necessary Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Santa Clara.
