CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION Minutes of the Commission December 20, 2010


Testimony was heard from the Appellant Regan Young.


The Commission voted unanimously to sustain Charges No. #1-6 in full. The Commission voted (5-0) to uphold the termination of Regan Young.
