



\*Note: the Redistricting Advisory Commission, at its 3/28/11 meeting, requested inclusion of several former unincorporated County pockets in the City of San Jose's population for redistricting purposes. While these former pockets were not incorporated as of Census Day (April 1, 2010), their subsequent annexation in November/December 2010 and the ready availability of definitive Census 2010 data for these areas allows a more accurate representation of San Jose's current demographic and geographic characteristics.

# City of San Jose Council District 1\*










# City of San Jose Council District 6\*



# Population Transfer Areas

“Population Transfer Areas” are geographic areas where boundary changes are being considered during the redistricting process.

Each population transfer area includes a unique alpha-numeric identifier (e.g., 5-8(a)), in accordance with a defined naming system, and associated census data indicating the number of persons that would be moved from one City Council District to another within a given area.





# City of San Jose Council District 4\*


