Key Updates:

- NUMMI Career Transition Center (NCTC), located at 1401 Parkmoor Avenue, San Jose, Suite 220, is open for NUMMI employees and suppliers.
- Submitted NEG application requesting \$5.4 million for additional assistance to provide intensive case management, training and other supportive services to NUMMI employees
- As of April, 1, 2010, 125 persons have accessed services at the NCTC. 325 are enrolled in Alameda County from the San Jose service area. Outreach continues to both NUMMI employees and impacted suppliers. Additional information is available through the Nummi.info website.
- 1,825 are registered through WIBs in the six counties that are most impacted

Key Issues:

- 4,700 employees were laid off on March 19-31, 2010
- 818 employees are from Santa Clara County
- 655 are from work2future service area
- 592 are from San Jose
- 450 individuals from suppliers may be affected
- Largest number of affected employees in work2future service area are from San Jose

- NUMMI has been TAA-certified: up to \$10,000 for training and other benefits

Suppliers to NUMMI:

- 30 Tier One Suppliers will be affected
- 35 Tier Two Suppliers will be affected
- 200 other suppliers will be directly or indirectly affected
- A total of 5 major suppliers in Santa Clara County
  - 1-Tier 1
  - 4-Tier 2
- Estimated 240 employees from Tiers 1 and 2 in Santa Clara County
- Undetermined number of secondary suppliers in Santa Clara County
- Meetings are continuing between EDD TAA managers and WIBs to develop TAA WIB co-enrollment process (no wrong door process)
