INFORMATION

The Department of Transportation is leading the development of the 2002 Annual Transportation Report (ATR). This is the ninth edition and marks a transition from a document focused solely on the activities of the DOT to a document reporting on the activities of the Transportation City Service Area (CSA). The publication was crafted with input from the Department of Public Works, the Police Department, the Airport, the Redevelopment Agency, and Planning, Building and Code Enforcement. The ATR aligns the contents of the document with the CSA Outcomes and Strategic Goals. Attached is an outline of the contents.

The report is intended to serve as an information resource for policy makers, transportation agencies and interested community members. The contents of the report includes:

- An overview of the City's transportation services and accomplishments
- The status of local and regional transportation projects
- Data on the performance of the transportation system
- Information on Public Safety Programs and Education and Outreach Programs
- Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Delivery

The production and distribution strategy of this year's report has been modified to respond to the City's anticipated budget constraints. This year, the Department will provide limited color copies while making the document available to the public on the Department's website. Additional black and white photocopy versions will be made available to members of the public lacking web access or to organizations that request copies from the Department. The document will be available in late May or early June.
