The Department of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services will provide a brief overview on the proposed plan to update and refine the Greenprint for Parks and Community Facilities and Programs adopted by the City Council in September 2000. The presentation will include a discussion of the following items to be included in the update strategy:

1. An outline of items to be addressed in the update including a discussion regarding updating of park planning standards, design guidelines, construction strategies, maintenance standards and programming plans.
2. A schedule and work program for the update.
3. Process to develop and complete a Greenprint "Infrastructure Report Card" on the State of the Park System that would examine the effectiveness of the Greenprint and Parks Bond in meeting the original vision, mission, goals and strategies set out in the Greenprint as related to programs and services, park and open space, citywide trails, recreation facilities and community centers.
4. Methods to update the Community Needs Assessment and involvement.
5. Methods to assure inclusion of community priorities.
