**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR DEFERRAL OF REPORT ON PUBLIC INTOXICATION
TASK FORCE IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE**

RECOMMENDATION

The San Jose Police Department (Department) is requesting a deferral of the Public Intoxication Task Force (PITF) Implementation update report to the April 15, 2010 Public Safety, Finance Strategic Support Committee (PSFSSC) meeting.

BACKGROUND

The Department was requested to present an update on the implementation of the PITF recommendations. During the process of data collection, the Department received a Public Records Act request that was related to the status of the PITF update report. The Department reviewed the request and believed that some of the information would be applicable to the update report.

ANALYSIS

Due to the competing workload of this request, Department staff anticipates the collection of this information will take approximately two additional weeks to complete. These workload issues are largely due to lack of staff needed to collect, review and compare data from different sources. In addition to the information requested by the PSFSSC, the Department is examining the information sought through the PRA and will incorporate it into the update report.

This information includes:

- A breakdown of arrests since the inception of the program (ethnicity, location of arrest, residency of subject, arrests per month, and number of violent felonies that have occurred in downtown)
- Preliminary Alcohol Screening (PAS) device usage (number of times requested, average readings, and interpretation of results).
