Re: San José Repertory Theatre- The Drama of Incompetence should end.

Mayor Gonzales and Members San José City Council;

As you consider the plight of the **San José Repertory Theatre** and other floundering Arts programs consider the following;

1. The San José Firefighters are working without a contract and are in arbitration.
2. OE3 (Operating Engineers Local 3) is working without a contract.
3. Garbage collection fees have unnecessarily increased due to substandard management of City resources.
4. City Park maintenance is differentially disappearing.
5. "Pot-Holes" are now the norm on City streets.
6. A lack of funded Street-Light maintenance leaves neighborhoods in the dark.
7. Municipal swimming pools are closed due to a lack of funding.
8. City Staffers conferring "gifts" upon themselves and third parties as revealed by our dutiful City Auditor and his honorable minions.

So, how can YOU justify bailing out the pitiful **San José Repertory Theatre** and other poorly managed Art programs? Outside of making a "gift" to the **San José Repertory Theatre, the Mexican Heritage Corporation, the American Musical Theater and others, you cannot justify these expenditures.** Unless YOU wish to PUBLICALLY invoke the doctrine of ULTRA VIRES.

I am not against public funding of the ARTS. I am for accountability and not for creating an entitlement program for administrative ne'er do wells.

If the **San José Repertory Theatre and others** are to survive, let them put up their own funding, establish a track record of fiscal success, then present their business plan for Council consideration. **Until then, take them off of life-support and let them die the death they have so justly deserve.**
