RECOMMENDATION

Approve the appointment of Hobin Kim to the Project Diversity Screening Committee; and

Approve the appointment of Jeannie LoFranco as Chair of the Project Diversity Screening Committee.

BACKGROUND

In 1991, Project Diversity was adopted by the Council as a process for recruiting and appointing board and commission members. There are 13 members on the Committee; seven are recommended by the Mayor and six are recommended by Council Members. Each December, approximately one-half of the terms expire. Committee members serve two years.

ANALYSIS

The purpose of this memorandum is to request that the Committee approve the appointment of Jeannie LoFranco as Chair of the Project Diversity Screening Committee as she has demonstrated her dedication to the Committee since first being appointed in 2007, and is a great asset to the Committee.

Also, it is requested that the Committee approve the appointment of Hobin Kim to the Project Diversity Screening Committee. Hobin Kim, who is the CEO of NuCross Inc. and the President of the Silicon Valley Korean Federation, has made significant contributions as a community organizer.
