BACKGROUND

San José was one of six cities selected to participate in the National Forum on Youth Violence to demonstrate best practices and create national policy. One of the requirements to participate was to update existing strategic workplans. The current Mayor's Gang Prevention Task Force (MGPTF) Strategic Work Plan is a live document that expires in December 2011; however, participation in the Forum required the City to update the document sooner. The MGPTF Policy Team adopted the new MGPTF Strategic Work Plan "Action Collaboration Transformation" on April 22, 2011.
