

ORDINANCE NO. 27650

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING CHAPTER 4.80 OF TITLE 4 OF THE SAN JOSE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING PART 52 TO ESTABLISH THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT TRUST FUND**

**WHEREAS**, the federal Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, United States Department of Justice administers the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (the "JAG Program") whereby grants are awarded to local jurisdictions for law enforcement purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, funds awarded to local jurisdictions are required to be deposited in a trust fund established by the local jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to establish the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Trust Fund in order to receive grant funds from the JAG Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:**

Chapter 4.80 of Title 4 of the San José Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a part to be numbered and entitled and to read as follows:

**Part 52**

**EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT TRUST FUND**

**4.80.3450 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Trust Fund Established.**

There is hereby established a special fund designated as the "Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Trust Fund."



**4.80.3480 Expenditures.**

Monies in the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Trust Fund, including interest earned, may be expended only for law enforcement purposes in accordance with the guidelines for the federal Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program.
