

ORDINANCE NO. 28290

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 28071 TO APPROPRIATE MONEYS IN THE SERVICES FOR REDEVELOPMENT CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR THE KINGMAN AVENUE AND LEIGH AVENUE; SAN ANTONIO AVENUE AND SCHARFF AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROJECT AND FOR THE CDBG FUNDED ADA ACCESSIBILITY RAMP CONSTRUCTION PROJECT; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION

WHEREAS, it has been certified that there will be available for appropriation in the Services for Redevelopment Capital Projects Fund in the fiscal year 2007-2008 moneys in excess of those heretofore appropriated therefrom, said excess being at least \$150,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

SECTION 1. Section 20.05 of Ordinance No. 28071 is hereby amended to read as fully set forth on EXHIBIT "A," entitled "AMENDMENTS TO ORD. 28071," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth in this Section of this Ordinance.
