ORDINANCE NO. 28713

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSÉ PREZONING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY SITUATED EAST OF MONTEREY ROAD, APPROXIMATELY 720 FEET SOUTH OF LEWIS ROAD, FROM COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA TO R-M MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENCE ZONING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, all prezoning proceedings required under the provisions of Chapter 20.120 of Title 20 of the San José Municipal Code have been duly had and taken with respect to the real property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the area encompassed by the subject proposed prezoning was the subject of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) prepared in conformance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA), as amended, and certified by the City Council on August 16, 1994; and

WHEREAS, this Council of the City of San José, acting as lead agency under CEQA, proposes to approve a project which was the subject of said EIR, to wit: the adoption of an ordinance prezoning certain real property hereinafter described to the R-M Multi-Family Residence Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, this Council has, on August 16, 1994, adopted Resolution No. 65459; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San José is the decision-making body for the proposed subject prezoning from unincorporated County to R-M Multi-Family Residence Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, this Council does hereby certify that, as the decision-making body, it has considered, approves and adopts the information contained in such EIR and Resolution No. 65459 prior to acting upon or approving such proposed project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

SECTION 1. All that real property hereinafter described in this section, hereinafter referred to as "subject property," is hereby prezoned as R-M Multi-Family Residence Zoning District.

The subject property referred to in this section is all that real property situated in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The district map of the City is hereby amended accordingly.

SECTION 3. The land development approval that is the subject of City File No. C09-013 is subject to the operation of Part 2.75 of Chapter 15.12 of Title 15 of the San José Municipal Code. The applicant for or recipient of such land use approval hereby acknowledges receipt of notice that the issuance of a building permit to implement such land development approval may be suspended, conditioned or denied where the City Manager has determined that such action is necessary to remain within the aggregate operational capacity of the sanitary sewer system available to the City of San José or to meet the discharge standards of the sanitary sewer system imposed by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board for the San Francisco Bay Region.

All that certain real property situated in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, being all of the property described in the Individual Grant Deed recorded on October 18, 1974 as Document No. 4878168, Official Records of Santa Clara County, said property being partially bounded by the City Limits Line of the City of San Jose as established by Franklin No. 5, Monterey Park No. 99, and Reorganization – Monterey Highway, said property being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the northeasterly line of said Reorganization – Monterey Highway with the southeasterly line of said Franklin No. 5, said point also being on the northeasterly line of Monterey Road as shown on that Record of Survey recorded on May 22, 1986 in Book 560 at Page 3, Records of Santa Clara County; thence along said southeasterly line of Franklin No. 5 and the northwesterly line of the Lands of Trailer Terrace as shown on said Record of Survey, N 50°00'00" E 685.66 feet to the most northerly corner of said Lands of Trailer Terrace, said point being on the southwesterly line of Tract No. 8893 recorded on June 2, 1997 in Book 689 of Maps at Pages 5-8, Records of Santa Clara, said point also being on the southwesterly line of said Monterey Park No. 99; thence along said southwesterly line of Tract No. 8893 and said southwesterly line of Monterey Park No. 99, S 38°30'00" E 209.34 feet to the most southerly corner of said Tract No. 8893, said point being on the general northwesterly line of Tract No. 355 "Southside Tract" recorded on September 3, 1946 in Book 11 of Maps at Pages 44-45, Records of Santa Clara County, said point also being the most southerly corner of said Monterey Park No. 99; thence along said general northwesterly line of Tract No. 355, S 50°04'00" W 685.36 feet to the northwesterly line of Monterey Road as shown on said Record of Survey, said point also being on said northeasterly line of Reorganization – Monterey Highway; thence along said northeasterly line of Monterey

Road and said northeasterly line of said Reorganization – Monterey Highway,
N 38°34'30" W 208.54 feet to the Point of Beginning.
