

ORDINANCE NO. 28809

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 28765 TO APPROPRIATE MONIES IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE SAN JOSE RETROFIT CALIFORNIA WHOLE NEIGHBORHOOD ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION

WHEREAS, it has been certified that there will be available for appropriation in the General Fund in the fiscal year 2010-2011 moneys in excess of those heretofore appropriated therefrom, said excess being at least \$374,012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

SECTION 1. Section 2.42 of Ordinance No. 28765 is hereby amended to read as fully set forth on EXHIBIT "A," entitled "AMENDMENTS TO ORD. 28765," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth in this Section of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption, pursuant to Section 605(c) of the Charter of the City of San Jose.
