

ORDINANCE NO. 28833

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 28765 TO APPROPRIATE MONIES IN THE CONSTRUCTION TAX AND PROPERTY CONVEYANCE TAX FUND: PARKS PURPOSES COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 7 FUND FOR THE NISICH PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECT; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION
