

RESOLUTION NO. 73032

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TROY CORLISS TO FABRICATE AND INSTALL AN ARTWORK AT EDENVALE BRANCH LIBRARY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$151,224**

**WHEREAS**, with the passage of Bond Measures O and P in November 2000, the City of San José ("City") is undertaking reconstruction, replacement or expansion of branch libraries and consistent with Title 22 of the San José Municipal Code, each eligible library project budget will include two percent (2%) for public art; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bond Measure recommendation calls for design and building of a new Edenvale Branch Library to be located at the corner of Monterey Road and East Branham Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 9, 2004, the Arts Commission approved the selection of artist Troy Corliss to create a public artwork at the Edenvale Branch Library and on October 12, 2005 the design proposal was approved by the Arts Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Tony Corliss to fabricate and install a work of art for the Edenvale Branch Library;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Tony Corliss for the fabrication and installation of a work of art for the Edenvale Branch Library in an amount not to exceed \$151,224.
