

RESOLUTION NO. 73048

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING (P.O.S.T.) RELATED TO LAW ENFORCEMENT DRIVER SIMULATOR TRAINING AND FORCE OPTION SIMULATOR TRAINING**

**WHEREAS**, in 1999, the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training ("P.O.S.T.") selected the San José Police Department ("SJPD") as a P.O.S.T. certified Regional Training Center and the Commission funded the purchase and installation of Force Option and Driver Training Simulators for the Training Center; and

**WHEREAS**, three sworn officer positions were added in fiscal year 2000-2001 to manage the program and are partially funded by P.O.S.T., which positions provide simulator training to both SJPD sworn personnel and sworn personnel from other participating local law enforcement agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to execute an agreement with P.O.S.T. for P.O.S.T. to fund thirty nine percent (39%) of the three SJPD officer positions assigned to provide driver simulator training, which officers will provide four hours of driver simulator training and four hours of force option simulator training to 1,000 law enforcement officers in Santa Clara County during the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, for a total reimbursement in an amount not to exceed \$158,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the State Police Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) to fund a portion of three SJPD officer positions assigned to provide driver simulator training, which officers will provide four hours of driver simulator training and four hours of force option simulator training to 1,000 law enforcement officers in Santa Clara County during the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 for a total reimbursement in an amount not to exceed \$158,000.
