

RESOLUTION NO. 73050

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH LAURA HADDAD AND TOM DRUGAN TO FABRICATE AND INSTALL AN ARTWORK AT FIRE STATION NO. 35 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$115,390**

**WHEREAS**, with the passage of the Public Safety Bond Measure in March 2002, the City of San José (“City”) is building or upgrading essential public safety municipal facilities, including police substations and fire stations, and each project budget includes two percent (2%) for public art; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2005, the Arts Commission approved the artist team of Laura Haddad and Tom Drugan to create a public artwork at Fire Station No. 35, and on November 9, 2005 the design proposal was approved by the Arts Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Laura Haddad and Tom Drugan to fabricate and install a work of art for Fire Station No. 35;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Laura Haddad and Tom Drugan for the fabrication and installation of a work of art for Fire Station No. 35 in an amount not to exceed \$115,390.
