

**RESOLUTION NO. 73126**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE (A) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH FILIPINO AMERICAN SENIOR OPPORTUNITIES DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, INC. (FILAM) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$110,000 OF HEALTHY NEIGHBORHOOD VENTURE FUNDS FOR ELIGIBLE SERVICES PROVIDED AT THE JACINTO "TONY" SEQUIG NORTHSIDE COMMUNITY CENTER (CENTER) FROM JULY 1, 2005 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2006, PROVIDED THE CITY HAS RECIVED REQUESTED SUPPORTING INFORMATION NO LATER THAN NOON, MARCH 30, 2006 AND SUCH INFORMATION IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE CITY MANAGER; AND (B) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO OFFER KEY FILAM SODC STAFF INVOLVED IN PROVIDING DIRECT SERVICES AT THE CENTER THE OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME TEMPORARY UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES WITH THE CITY IN THE EVENT THAT THE NOON, MARCH 30, 2006 DEADLINE IS NOT MET OR THE INFORMATION IS UNACCEPTABLE AS SUBMITTED.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2006, the Making Government Work Better Committee (MGWB) directed staff to clarify and provide information on recommendations made at the MGWB meeting for discussion at the March 28, 2006 City Council meeting; and . This item was deferred to the April 4, 2006 Council meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, this item was deferred to the April 4, 2006 Council meeting and the discussion behind the above recommendations are more specifically set forth in the Report of the Acting Director or Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Service dated March 28, 2006.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:**

- (A) THE City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute a reimbursement agreement with Filipino American Senior Opportunities Development Council, Inc. (FILAM) in an amount not to exceed \$110,000 of Healthy Neighborhood Venture Funds for eligible services provided at Jacinto "Tony" Sequig Northside Community Center (CENTER) from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, provided the CITY has received requested supporting information no later than Noon, March 30, 2006 and such information is acceptable to the City Manager;

- (B) The City Manager is authorized to offer key FILAM SODC staff involved in providing direct services at the CENTER the opportunity to become temporary unclassified employees with the CITY in the event that the Noon, March 30, 2006 deadline is not met or the information is unacceptable as submitted, both as more specifically set forth in the report of the Acting Director of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services dated March 28, 2006.
