

RESOLUTION NO. 73127

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ASSISTANCE MODIFICATION NUMBER SEVEN TO THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION TO PARTIALLY REIMBURSE AIRPORT FUNDED POLICE DEPARTMENT COSTS FOR FOUR EXPLOSIVE DETECTION CANINE TEAMS

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2002, the San Jose City Council adopted a resolution authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Transportation Security Administration ("TSA") to partially reimburse Airport funded Police Department costs for three explosive detection canine teams for a total cost of \$120,000 per year, for a period of five years; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2005, funding for one additional team was approved by TSA under Assistance Modification Number Six; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2006, the Airport was notified that TSA is increasing the reimbursement for each canine unit from \$40,000 to \$50,000 to fund the upcoming requirements to increase focused screening/searches at the Airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute Assistance Modification Number Seven to the Cooperative Agreement with the Transportation Security Administration to partially reimburse Airport funded Police Department costs for four explosive detection canine teams in the amount of \$160,500 from October 1, 2004

to September 30, 2005, and for a total of \$200,000 per year from October 1, 2005 to April 16, 2007, at the Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport.
