

RESOLUTION NO. 73203

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN JOSE ACCEPTING SB 720 FUNDS FROM THE
COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$1,810,317**

WHEREAS, in 1988, Santa Clara County and all incorporated cities, including the City of San José (“City”), entered into a Joint Powers Agreement for the local CAL-ID Remote Access Network (“RAN”) Policy Board, which is administered by the City through the Police Department’s Central Identification Unit; and

WHEREAS, the CAL-ID RAN Policy Board has agreed to share fiscal responsibility for all future upgrades to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System which is critical to the criminal data system used by 40 county, city and state law enforcement agencies, including the City’s Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Phases I and II of the Police Department’s upgrade strategy have been completed, and in January, 2006 the CAL-ID RAN Policy Board and the Santa Clara County Chief’s Association approved Phase III of an upgrade to the AFIS, which includes upgrade of the existing mugshot component to update the photo capture, storage and retrieval capability of the system; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2006, the County Board of Supervisors approved full funding in an amount not to exceed \$1,810,316.50 for the Phase III costs using SB 720 funds and provided a check to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The SB 720 funding from the County of Santa Clara in the amount of \$1,810,317 is hereby accepted.
