

RESOLUTION NO. 73510

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A TRANSPORTATION FOR CLEAN AIR GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$640,000 FROM THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, AND TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (“VTA”) has approved Transportation Fund for Clean Air grants for two transportation projects of the City of San José (“City”), in an amount not to exceed \$640,000; and

WHEREAS, the VTA approved \$600,000 for the Light Rail Transit Controller Upgrade Project, which will replace 41 of 94 existing light rail traffic signal controllers along Guadalupe, Tasman, Capitol and Vasona light rail corridors; and

WHEREAS, the VTA approved \$40,000 for the Installation of Sidewalk Bicycle Racks, which will install approximately 200 inverted-U bicycle racks on public sidewalks in areas of high demand, including commercial, retail and shopping districts; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with the VTA to effectuate the grant for the two projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept a Transportation Fund for Clean Air grant from the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority in an amount not to exceed \$640,000 for the following two transportation projects:
 - a. Light Rail Transit Controller Upgrade Project, in an amount not to exceed \$600,000;

- b. Installation of Sidewalk Bicycle Racks, in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.
2. The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute any documents necessary to effectuate the grant.
