

RESOLUTION NO. 73520

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR THE USE OF ADMINISTRATION CITATION FINES COLLECTED BY THE CITY FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE AIRPORT CURFEW

WHEREAS, under the Airport Curfew Ordinance, the Director of Aviation has authority to issue administrative citation fines of \$2,500 to any person responsible for each curfew violation; and

WHEREAS, as of the end of October 2006, the City has collected \$316,160 in curfew administrative citation fines; and

WHEREAS, in early April 2006, the City invited the community to submit ideas and suggestions for the use of the available funds; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Commission considered and reviewed suggestions received from the community and recommends to Council the following four Programs for funding:

- The Fly Quiet Program;
- Airport Internship Program;
- Alternative Fuel Grant Program; and
- Employ a consultant to facilitate the development of detailed design guidelines for the Guadalupe River Park and Gardens Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The following four programs are approved for development by staff and shall be funded using the Curfew administrative citation fines collected by the City for enforcement of the Airport Curfew:

- The Fly Quiet Program – implementation cost of \$72,000, with on-going annual cost of approximately \$32,000 for professional services from the vendor, with the Program to be reviewed after two years;
- Airport Internship Program, at a cost of \$28,800 per year for the Spring, Summer and Fall Semesters for 4 students per semester, as an on-going Program;
- Alternative Fuel Grant Program to assist ground transportation providers at the Airport to convert their gasoline vehicles to compressed natural gas, with individual grants limited to \$2,000 per sedan and \$4,000 per van up to a total cost of \$75,000 for one year to convert or procure up to 37 sedans or 18 vans; and
- Employ a consultant to facilitate the development of detailed design guidelines for the Guadalupe River Park and Gardens Master Plan for a one time cost of \$50,000.
