

RESOLUTION NO. 73668

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH APEX STRATEGIES TO DEVELOP A TRANSPORTATION MAINTENANCE MASTER PLAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$155,000**

**WHEREAS**, the transportation infrastructure of the City of San José (“City”) includes roadways, median islands, roadway markings, sidewalks, curb and gutters, traffic signal systems, traffic signs, and street lights, and is essential to the basic function, safety and livability of San José; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s Building Better Transportation Committee has directed City staff to develop a Transportation Maintenance Master Plan (“TMMP”) which would identify community support and priorities for infrastructure maintenance and improvements as well as potential funding sources; and

**WHEREAS**, in Fall of 2006, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) to find a consultant with expertise to assist the City in preparing a TMMP; and

**WHEREAS**, Apex Strategies responded to the RFQ, and the evaluation panel determined that Apex Strategies was qualified to perform the services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Apex Strategies in an amount not to exceed \$155,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Apex Strategies to develop a Transportation Maintenance Master Plan, in an amount not to exceed \$155,000.
