

RESOLUTION NO. 73715

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FRIENDS OF GUADALUPE RIVER PARK & GARDENS TO DEVELOP A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE GUADALUPE GARDENS MASTER PLAN TO INCLUDE DESIGN GUIDELINES AND A PREFERRED LOCATION FOR A DOG PARK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000

WHEREAS, the Friends of Guadalupe River Park & Gardens (“Friends”) have served for many years as the City of San José’s (“City”) non-profit partner in the development of both Guadalupe River Park and Guadalupe Gardens, consisting of approximately 120 acres of City-owned Airport Approach Zone property bounded by Coleman Avenue, Interstate 880 and the Guadalupe River Park; and

WHEREAS, the Friends has worked with the City and community stakeholders to develop a Master Plan for Guadalupe Gardens (“Gardens Master Plan”), which was adopted by the City Council of the City of San José (“City Council”) and approved by the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) in 2002; and

WHEREAS, since the existing Gardens Master Plan is limited in detail regarding specific implementation and design guidelines, the City Council has recommended the Friends assist in managing the development of design guidelines for an update of the Gardens Master Plan, incorporating planning for a dog park; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2006, the City Council adopted a resolution establishing a policy for the use of the administrative citation of fines, specifically addressing

revenue from noise curfew fines, to include the Friend's proposal to use \$50,000 to hire a consultant for the update of the Gardens Master Plan, and additionally, on February 13, 2007 the City Council approved an additional \$26,000 as part of the mid-year budget process; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute a grant agreement with the Friends of Guadalupe River Park & Gardens to develop a proposed amendment to the Guadalupe Gardens Master Plan to include design guidelines and a preferred location for a dog park in an amount not to exceed \$75,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a grant agreement with the Friends of Guadalupe River Park & Gardens to develop a proposed amendment to the Guadalupe Gardens Master Plan to include design guidelines and a preferred location for a dog park in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.
